A few reminders:

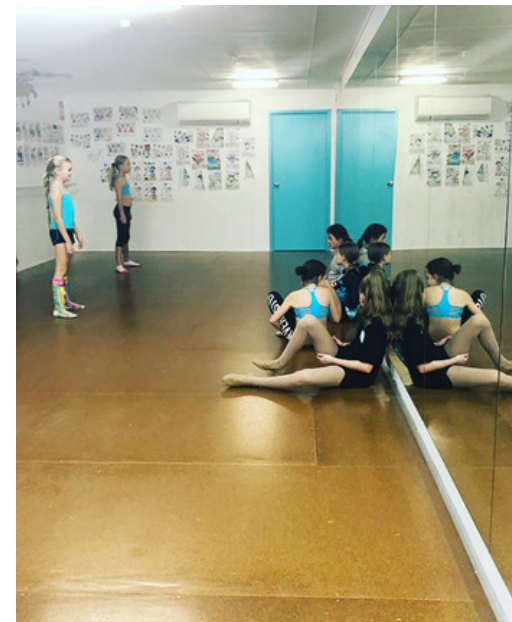
